



Prescribing of iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste and Orahesive[®] Powder Position Statement

Hertfordshire and West Essex ICB recommends a monthly maximum of <u>two</u> tubes of iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste OR <u>one</u> bottle of Orahesive[®] Powder to be prescribed per patient, on an acute basis, for a maximum of two months.

iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste and Orahesive[®] Powder are used to protect excoriated skin and promote healing. They are not used in the same way as other stoma pastes and fillers.

Recommendations

- Maximum monthly quantity of two tubes of iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste OR <u>one</u> bottle of Orahesive[®] Powder to be prescribed, on acute, for a maximum of two months.
- Patients prescribed iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste or Orahesive[®] Powder in excess of two months should be referred to their local stoma care nurse for review.

Rationale

- iLEX[®] Skin Protectant Paste is formulated to protect excoriated skin.
- Orahesive[®] Powder is formulated to adhere to mucous membrane and raw weeping areas to promote healing.
- Therefore, both of these products are for short term use only.
- Using more than two tubes or one bottle a month is an indication that there is a stoma related issue requiring a clinical review.
- There may be exceptional cases where the stoma care nurse recommends more than two tubes or one bottle a month to be prescribed, or for longer than a two month period. This should be communicated by the local stoma care nurse.
