

Position Statement: Treatment of diabetic hypos in primary care with prescribed products

Herts Valleys CCG <u>does not</u> support prescribing of products to treat hypos: Purchase of a food product to treat hypos is recommended instead

Recommendations:

- 1. Do not prescribe high glucose products to treat hypos
- 2. Instead recommend any of the following purchased products as hypo treatments and recommend:
 - Knowing the person's preferences (as that will influence what they will take) e.g. 200ml orange juice, a few jelly babies, glucose tablets or a high sugar (not diet) drink
 - Having the persons choice of product available at any time in case of a hypo
- 3. Recommend that patients/parents/carers plan ahead in order to effectively treat a hypo

The following table demonstrates which readily available, purchased products can be used to treat a hypo and how much of each is required to provide 15g fast acting carbohydrate:
